If a team makes a Par, they stay at the same set of tees

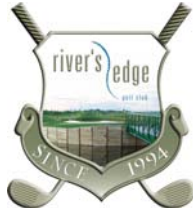
If a team makes Bogey or worse, return to your respective front tee

Woman's Tees (Orange-Red-White)**

SNOWBALL SCRAMBLE RULES SHEET

Registration:

Begins at 9:30am. Rules sheet will be provided with your scorecards. Complimentary range balls are available to participants. Please bring cash if you are playing the games below..

Team Buy In (Optional):

If you choose to buy your team you must do so prior to play in the clubhouse. You will only be competing against the other teams within your flight. Team Buy ins are as follows:

A Flight:	\$ 200 / Team
B Flight:	\$ 75 / Team
C Flight:	\$ 50 / Team
D - E Flight:	\$ 20 / Team

Payout for 7 or more teams entered in your flight: 50% for 1st, 30% for 2nd, 20% for 3rd.
Payout for 6 or less teams entered in your flight: 65% for 1st, 35% for 2nd.

Please Note: If there is a tie, the money will be split.

Snips Pot (Optional):

Snips pot is for all teams in the event. If your team wins a hole outright over every other team entered, you win a share of the pot. If no team wins a snip, we will have a draw at the end to determine the winner. To enter the snips pot, it is \$ 20 / Team and the payout is normally very big. All it takes is one lucky shot.

50/50 Draw (Optional):

50/50 tickets are available to purchase prior to the round. We will be giving away at minimum a Ping G425 Driver (Value \$700) to the winner. Tickets are 1 for \$10 or 3 for \$20.

Event Format:

- * 2 person patriot style scramble.
- * 2 person teams may consist of any combination of men, woman or senior men.
- * Stroke play event.
- * Flights will be based on combined team handicap
- * Ties will be settled by retrogression starting on hole 18.

IMPORTANT!!

For teams that add to a combined team handicap of 5 or lower, each player must use **9 DRIVES EACH**.
For teams that add to a combined team handicap of 6 - 10, each player must use **8 DRIVES EACH**.
For teams that add to a combined team handicap of 11 or higher, each player must use **7 DRIVES EACH**.

Event Rules:

- 1) In a 2 person scramble, both players tee off. You then choose the best shot and both hit from the next position. You repeat the process until your ball is holed.
- 2) Men begin play from the white tees. Each time you make birdie or better, you move back **ONE** set of tees until you reach the blacks. If you par a hole, you remain at the same tee. Anytime you make bogey or worse on a hole, you **GO BACK** to the white tees. **(MEN: WHITE-BLUE-BLACK)**
- 3) Senior Men (55+) begin play from the red tees. Each time you make birdie or better, you move back **ONE** set of tees until you reach the blues. If you par a hole, you remain at the same tee. Anytime you make bogey or worse on a hole, you **GO BACK** to the red tees. **(SENIOR MEN: RED-WHITE-BLUE)**
- 4) Woman begin play from the orange tees (pylons). Each time you make birdie or better, you move back **ONE** set of tees until you reach the whites. If you par a hole, you remain at the same tee. Anytime you make bogey or worse on a hole, you **GO BACK** to the orange tees (pylons). **(WOMEN: ORANGE-RED-WHITE)**
- 5) You may bump or place your golf ball within one club length no nearer to the hole where the ball chosen came to rest. This rule also applies to balls coming to rest in a bunker or hazard.
- 6) You cannot change the type of lie where a ball is resting. For example, you cannot move a ball from the rough to the fairway, fairway to green, hazard to rough, long rough to short rough, etc.
- 7) Yardage devices of all types are permitted.
- 8) For all other rules of play, Golf Canada and local rules apply.
- 9) Exchange scorecards with the group you are playing with prior to the round.

Hole Prizes:

Hole #2:	Closest in 2
Hole #3:	Long Putt
Hole #6:	Closest to Pin
Hole #9:	Closest to Pin
Hole #11:	\$ 10,000 hole-in-one (amateurs only)
Hole #16:	Long Drive (Both Men & Ladies)
Hole #17:	Closest to Pin

Hole In One Prizes:

Holes #6, #9, #17: (10) 18 Hole Unrestricted Passes to River's Edge. Hole #11: \$10,000 Hole-in-One.
